Bird Id / Walk

- Learn how to identify different types of birds by shape, size, color, and other characteristics. All students will have a pair of binoculars to use during the program.

Orienteering 1 (Geared for students 10y & up)

- In this fun guided program, students will learn how to use a compass and explore their surroundings.

Orienteering 2 (Geared for students 10y & up)(maximum 12 students)

- Students would have completed Orienteering 1 from Fall Home School Jamboree to be able to sign up for this class. Students will use their orienteering skills to guide them on a course throughout the park. This program goes through two time program slots, 1:10p – 2:50p.

Birds of Prey

- Have you ever hooted like a Barred Owl, checked out a Turkey Vulture up close, or even glared at a Red-tailed Hawk? Here is your chance to learn about these magnificent birds up close with some permanently injured residents from Eagle Creek Park.

Reptiles & Amphibians

- Frogs, turtles, and snakes! Oh My! Explore these fascinating creatures up close and learn why they are so-o important for the environment. Each student will make frog slime to take home

Tree Id

- Discover how to identify different trees via leaves, branches, and more

Pond Study

- Using nets, explore the diversity of an Indiana pond habitat up close

Beavers, Boats, & Bannock

- Explore the history of the Indiana frontier and fur trade with this fun-filled program

Animal Signs & Tracks

- Be a scientist studying the signs of animals, even when you don't see them. Each student will make a plaster track to take home.
